

Four-Generation Charts

We have asked every member of the Genealogical Society of Stanislaus County to fill out a four-generation chart to put in our four generation books.

These charts will help you in your genealogical research. There have been numerous times these charts have found other members in our society that are researching the same ancestors or found that they were related in one way or another. If you haven't looked at your charts that you may have turned in YEARS AGO, please take a look at them and update for our records.

If you have not turned in your four-generation charts, please do so. If you do not know how to fill out the four generation charts, please let me know and I will help you with it.

At a recent Board of Directors Meeting, we discussed the possibility of putting all of our four-generation charts (pedigree) on line, on our web site. This would aide other researchers in their research efforts. In order to do this we would need your permission to do so. Let me tell you how this would work.

The pedigree charts would only have your membership number on them. If someone needed to get in touch with you, for information on people listed on your charts, they would send you an e-mail and it would be up to you to correspond to the interested party. Thereby your personal information (ie. name, phone number or address, etc.) would not be out there for everyone to see. This would make it secure from theft.
